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### Where are the hidden items?

The moon is part of the hair of the Clover kid (in the upper right of the  $\zeta$ circle), the **pencil** is one of the poles in the swing set, the donut is a wheel on the truck, the envelope is the back part of the truck, the letter "B" makes up the sunglasses for the Clover kid (in the lower right of the circle), the popcorn is the last bush, the ring is a wheel for the wheelchair, the letter "W" is part of the crown, the **2 triangles** are the Clover girl's dress (in the bottom of the circle) and the middle of the teeter totter, the **cherry** is on the top of the recycling can.
