

We are excited to announce that the New England 4-H Horse Show will be July 26-29 at The Eastern States Exposition Grounds in West Springfield Mass. Connecticut participants need to be 12 years of age (on or before January 1/2021) and have a verified 4-H horse project on file in your UConn 4-H office as of MAY 1, 2021. There will be no other selection process. Anyone can attend that fits the criteria, you must do your own entry and provide for all of your housing and supervision.

You will need to review the **4-H Horse packet**, complete the checklist and register on line using the **4-H Horse Online Entry** link.
