The 4H Fair Committee is also working to grow the fair with some great changes in the last year. They are now giving premiums to 4Hers who show their projects. We are hoping to have this be a good draw for families outside of Windham County. That being said, I do want to be transparent in the numbers we had before this change. Last year's fair drew in approximately 400-500 patrons.

This event is advertised in the Turnpike Buyer, Shopper's Guide, WINY Radio, Currant Community, Facebook Ads, and lawn signs throughout Windham County.

We are hoping to attract a variety of vendors this year. Only 1 of each type of Commercial Direct Sales Vendor is allowed, first come, first served.

This event is indoors in the Brooklyn Fairgrounds Better Living Building. The 4H Home Show will be in the same building to draw attention to both events.
